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## CONVENTIONS VERB TENSES

A verb expresses an action or a state of being. The **tense** of a verb shows when the action happens or the state exists. In English, there are six common verb tenses.

Present Tense	The action is happening now or happens regularly.	Pat <b>paints</b> something every day.
Past Tense	The action has already happened.	Pat <b>painted</b> the porch yesterday.
Future Tense	The action will happen later.	Pat will paint the steps on Friday.
Present Perfect Tense	The action happened in the past and may still be happening now.	Pat <u>has painted</u> the kitchen once before.
Past Perfect Tense	The action ended before another action in the past.	Pat had painted the bedrooms before I arrived.
Future Perfect Tense	The action will have ended before a specific time.	By the end of next week, Pat <u>will</u> <u>have painted</u> the living room and dining room.
