

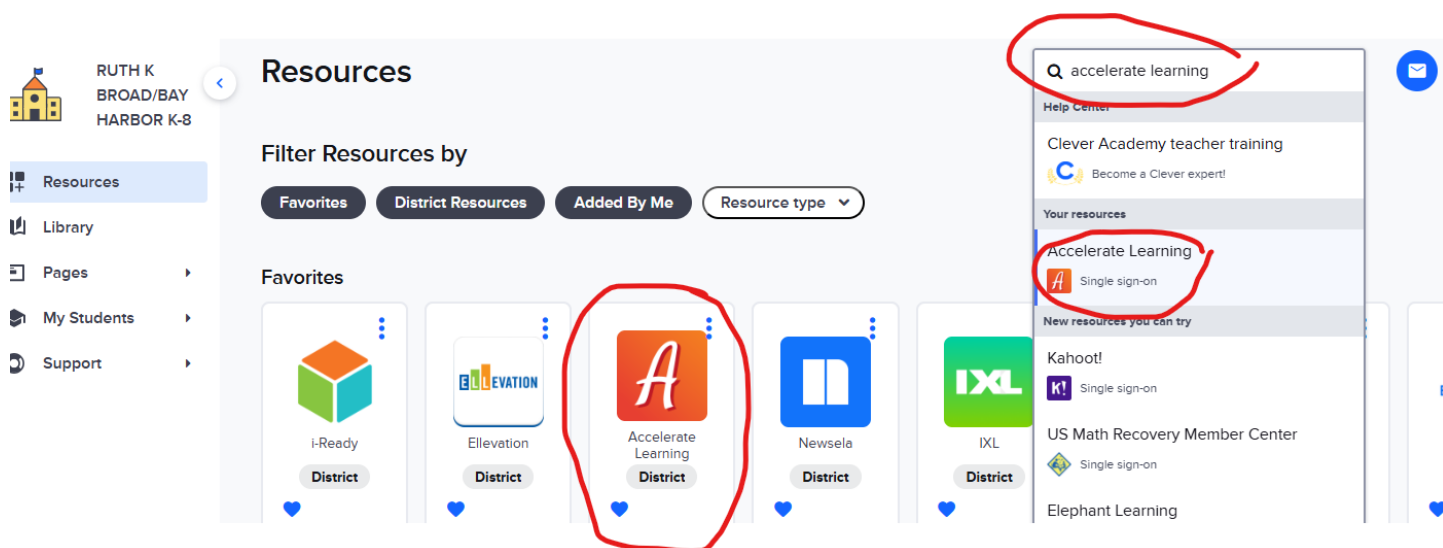
2025-26 Incoming Pre-Algebra (Accelerated 7th Grade and Regular 8th Grade) Students Summer Assignment
